REPOSITIONING TILE

- If you need to remove or reposition a tile after setting, grip it firmly with two hands and pry it off by pulling it back and down from the wall – if you need to, you can also gently pry the tile off with a flat-head screwdriver.
- To reattach the tile, apply more adhesive to the wall surface or to the tile back, wait at least ten minutes, or until there is no heavy transfer of adhesive using the touch test, and then reset the tile in the correct position.
- This is a good time to use some of those tiles you back buttered while spraying the wall. The tile you removed can be back buttered for use later or can just be applied in another position where a tile has not yet been set.



To remove a tile, pull it back and down from the wall.



Be sure to apply more adhesive when re-affixing the tile.
